Tips for adjusting kids back to school schedules:

- Gradually adjust sleep and wake times
- Establish a consistent bedtime routine
- Create a calming sleep environment
- Healthy diet, encourage healthy meals and a well-balanced breakfast.

School mornings can become very busy, below are some quick and easy breakfast ideas to make before school:

- **Yogurt Parfait:** Layer Greek yogurt in a cup with granola and fresh berries.
- **PB & Banana Roll-Up:** Spread peanut butter on a soft tortilla, place a whole banana inside, roll it up, and slice.
- **Quick Oats:** Boil quick oats in milk or water for 1 to 2 minutes, then stir in honey and sliced fruit.
- **Nut Butter Toast:** Toast whole-wheat bread, spread peanut or almond butter, and top with banana slices or chia seeds

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Toddler Speech Therapy: Tips for encouraging speech at home:

Toddlers first few years of life are the most critical in his and her learning process.

- ✓ Slow down- Don't forget to slow down how fast you talk too, especially if your child is struggling with speech and language development.
- ✓ Look at Your Toddler/Child and Get Down at His/Her Level
- ✓ Wait- Make sure you allow enough time for your child to respond to you.
- ✓ Stop counting and start communicating- When your child points at something, talk about it. Ask questions and wait for them to answer. Narrate what you both are doing. Talk to them, don't just sing the ABCs.
- ✓ Rethink your toys- Limit bright colored toys that light up and play music; the toys are doing all the work and not letting the kids explore. The basic balls and blocks are great toys!
